## **Osteoporosis:** the silent disease

Osteoporosis is a bone disease that affects one in every two women and one in every five men from the age of 50.

Many of the fractures occurring over the age of 50 are caused by calcium loss.

Loss of calcium, which leads to progressive weakening of bones by loss of bone density, results in an increased susceptibility to fractures.

Often calcium loss is not detected until the stage at which the bones become quite fragile and prone to fractures from even the slightest blow. It may cause serious disruption to daily life, disability and may even shorten life expectancy .

## Who should have a **Bone Destiny Scan?**

### Men and women who:

- Have broken a bone after a minor trauma
- Feel shorter during the past few years
- Have a family history of osteoporosis
- Used steroids for prolonged periods
- Do not engaged in a regular physical activity
- Regularly consume alcohol, caffeine or smoke
- Have a medical condition which affects the absorption of food
- Are underweight/ have an eating disorder
- Are above 40 as a routine checkup

### Women who:

- Have an early menopause or hysterectomy (under the age of 45)
- Have missed periods for six months or more (excluding pregnancy)

### Men who:

- Have low testosterone levels

**Note:** We cannot carry out a scan on pregnant women.
